<ul> <li>Teach Appreciation Week Update – Rachel Palmer</li> <li>R.Palmer confirmed dates as 2/25-2/31</li> <li>Budget of \$2000 to be spent on Amazon gift cards except for \$100 to be spent on décor, etc, and decorated cookies made by R.Palmer. Staff/teachers confirmed that they prefer to receive money instead of massages.</li> <li>Weekday themes/treats to be:         <ol> <li>Monday – We Love Staff/Teachers</li> <li>Tuesday - Flowers</li> <li>Wednesday – Wear teacher's favorite color and help teacher</li> <li>Thursday – Notes</li> <li>Food everyday of the week, i.e breakfast (TK-K)/ lunch soup (1st grade), and 2nd-5th have their own days of providing food breakfast and lunch.</li> <li>A.Stuffmann noted that teachers/staff like soup and salad days and that salad is good midweek because it can be eaten the next day.</li> <li>J.Manheimer indicated that Hester and Celia do join teachers in food treats.</li> <li>Debbie organizes all food.</li> <li>K.Kiang suggested "coffee bar" with barista – which Sleepy Hollow has done.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>	R.Palmer
<ul> <li>School lunches and kitchen dishwasher – Chef Basil</li> <li>School lunches:         <ul> <li>Chef Basil suggested eliminating snacks for Kindergarten so that they eat lunch and do not waste food - as K is most wasteful out of all the grades. According to aides who already remind students to take small portions first and come back for more if they finish, kindergarteners still take too much and typically eat only half of what they've taken. Basil already provides smaller portions for the kindergarteners and none come back for seconds.</li> <li>All agree that Basil can reduce portions further and maintain same pricing as other grades since kindergarteners can come back for seconds without extra charge.</li> <li>J.Mathews requested less dressing on salads.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Chef Basil Chef Basil
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#### Dishwasher:

- Chef Basil indicated support for installing dishwasher in kitchen to wash utensils and eliminate plastic disposable utensils. Current weekly spending on plastic utensils is about \$100.
- Chef Basil noted that shrinkage will occur with non-disposable utensils.
- All agree that dishwasher use and elimination of disposable plastics should be pursued.
- J.Mathews reminded that kid-size utensils should be purchased.
- S.Hua noted that reminders would be required to check recycling bins for utensils at end of lunch shifts.
- K.Mahlberg and S.Son to look into dishwasher options.
